ASEC 2015 programme overview

ASEC 2015 features a plenary session track of paper presentations in the main theatre, supported by 3 parallel tracks for tutorials and breakout sessions. This year we have introduced 3 new elements into the programme:

- An SE Handbook "boot camp", acting as a short primer to the SE Handbook v4.
- 3x 90 minute sessions for Working Groups to use for briefings, meetings or workshops.
- A "Fringe" session consisting of two parallel sets of faciliated discussions on topics suggested and agreed by the delegates, covering 2-3 topics per group per session, with group feedback at the end.

There will be an "ice-breaker" reception on the evening before the main programme begins.
